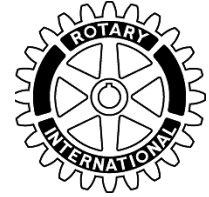

GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

As a recipient of The Beaverton Rotary College Scholarship, you are allowed to reapply each new school year for another scholarship. The maximum cumulative number of scholarships per student is four. Scholarships are awarded annually with payments made to the school at the beginning of the school year.

Recipients must be attending a four-year, public or private college or university or a two-year community college located in OREGON.

The Beaverton Rotary Club and its Scholarship Committee do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, age, religion, sex, national origin or physical disability in keeping with the spirit of equal opportunity and compliance with all civil rights laws.

Applicants will be selected based on the completeness of their application, academic achievement, community service, financial need, written presentation, and interview.

Applicants must participate in a personal interview in April. We prefer in-person interviews, but telephone interviews will be allowed. The Scholarship Committee will notify applicants as to the schedule for these meetings/interviews in late April. Although the committee will make every effort to accommodate scheduling conflicts, applicants who are not available for the interview and oral presentation will not be considered for a scholarship. Successful applicants will be recognized at a special meeting of the Beaverton Rotary Club in June.
